Kindergarten

Shared supplies (do not label)

- 1 package dry erase markers (low odor, Expo brand preferred)

Shared supplies (do not label)

- Pocket Folders (2) plain, solid colored folders with pockets on the bottom and not on the side. Prefer Mead Five Star Brand or Poly (plastic) folders. They are more durable.
- 2 rolls of masking tape or scotch tape
- 1 container of baby wipes or disinfecting wipes.
- Washable markers- 1 box of "Classic Colors" markers (no fine tip or special kinds please).

- Water colored paint- 2 sets
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 package of plates (small or large)
- 2 boxes of Ziploc type baggies, 1 gallon & 1 quart
- 1 container of Play-Doh, your child's favorite color OR 2 cans of shaving cream. Any scent is fine.
