Scaffolds and supports will be added to already robust lessons to make sure there is equitable access for all to high quality, core instruction. 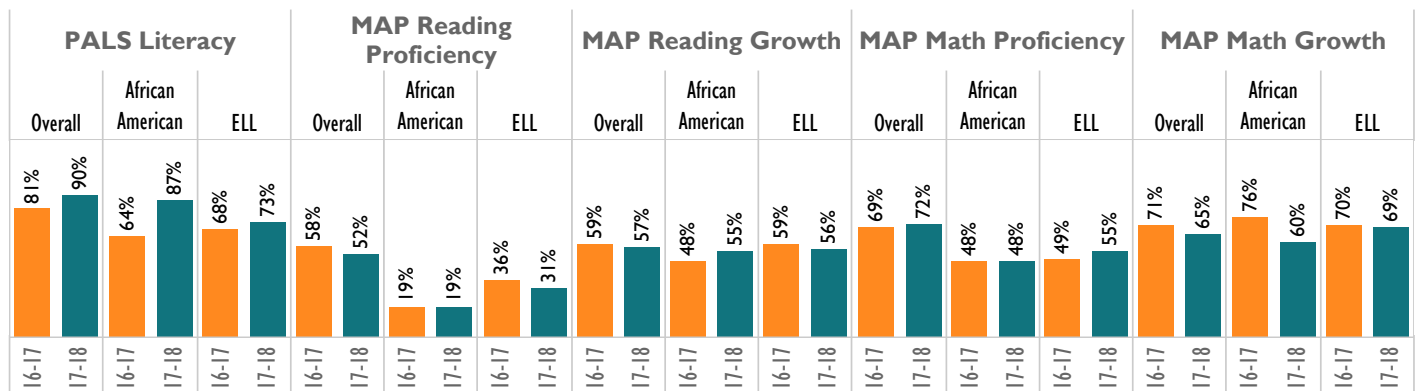

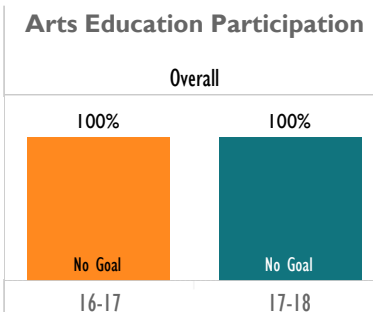
