Our new library media center features an engaging makerspace area, as well as thousands of books for students to check out. We are proud to be one of the first cohort of schools selected to integrate technology into our daily instruction with all students having individual devices.

Progress

During the 2017-18 school year our staff focused on learning more about culturally relevant teaching practices and becoming more aware of implicit bias. In our content & instructional practice we continued to focus on reading. Specifically we worked on ways to improve students' ability to access increasingly complex texts by bringing a tighter alignment between the shared reading learning targets and independent practice.

Area for Growth

During the 2018-19 school year, Huegel staff will focus on developing learning partnerships with students, improving student to student relationships, and providing increased opportunities for student voice and choice in their learning. We will also work on implementing the new Math Bridges curriculum with fidelity.

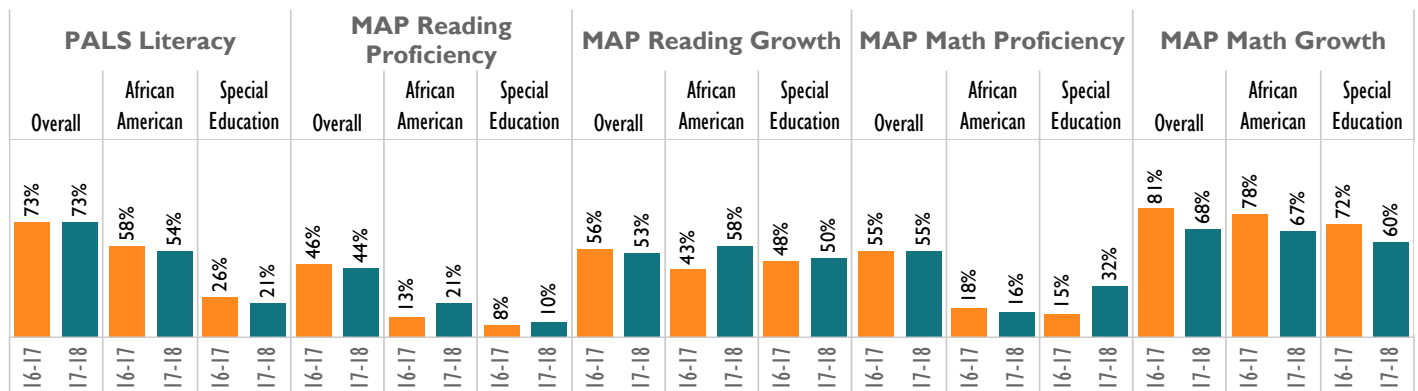

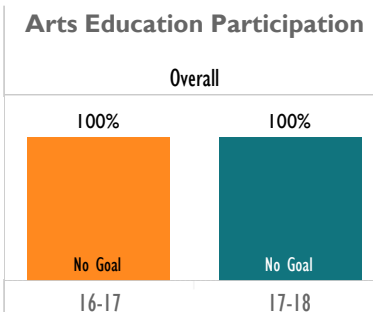
