Our work is guided by our school improvement plan and progress monitored throughout the year. Students have access to standards-based curriculum, collaborative learning experiences, and social/emotional learning standards and lessons to prepare them with the critical thinking skills they need to become career, college, and community ready.

Equity Vision

The Toki community will empower all of our students to meet high expectations, to feel safe and included, and to achieve personal and academic excellence, while actively working to recognize, examine, and disrupt patterns of bias.

Strengths

Toki's key strengths are the diversity of our student body and a student-centered staff. Students have creativity and leadership opportunities that raise student voice and encourage them to share feedback. Our staff works collaboratively and plans intentionally to respond to student needs and provide access to the core curriculum.

Progress

Over 55 % of our African American students met their growth goals in Math and Reading. Over 60% of our Special Education students met their growth goals in Math and Reading. 6th Grade exceeded their growth goals in Math and Reading. The number of reported behavior incidents is declining over the last three years and there has been a specific decrease in the number of African American students being suspended.

Area for Growth

As a staff we will continue professional development as it relates to race and equity with the purpose of serving our school community. We will deepen our understanding and use of inclusive practices in order to foster a sense of belonging for all students.

Our school supports MMSD's vision that all students acquire the skills and abilities needed to be successful, including a mastery of content areas, growth mindset, self-knowledge, creativity, wellness, interpersonal skills, confidence, cultural competence, and community connection. 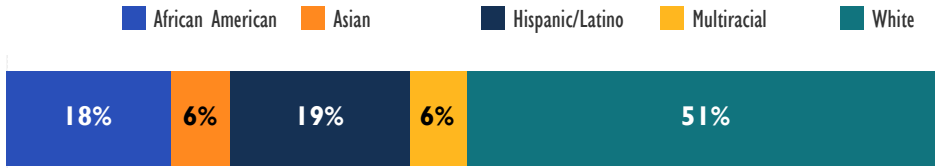

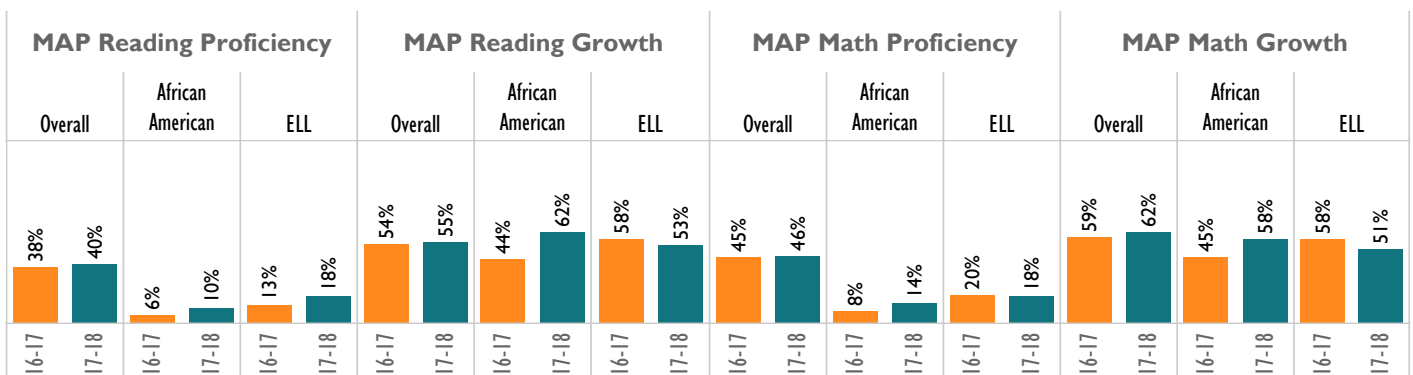

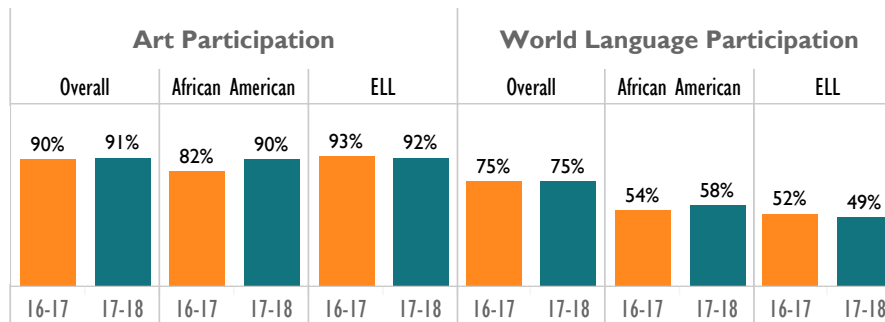
