Kindergarten

Please label with child's name

- Four Pocket folders with bottom pockets.
- Two Spiral bound notebooks, wide lined, no larger than 70 count. Labeled on front.
- One Composition notebook, wide lines
- One Large backpack or school bag to be brought to school every day.
- One Change of clothes for season (socks, underwear, pants, shirt). Labeled in plastic bag.
- One child sized headphones (no earbuds please).

First Grade

Shared Supplies (do not label):

- 1 box gallon-size storage bags (Students with last names beginning with A-L only.)

Shared Supplies (do not label):

- 2 dozen pencils –sharpened (Dixon Ticonderoga preferred)
- 1 box of tissues

- 1 pack 3x3 sticky notes (post it preferred)
- 2 pink erasers (not pencil cap erasers)
- 1 package of 20 plastic page protectors for three ring binders
- Last names A-M 3-felt tip markers, fine tip (any color)
- Last names N-Z 3-highlighters (any color)
- 1 pkg dry erase markers (Expo preferred), chisel tip, primary colors
- 1 box snack, sandwich **or** gallon size plastic bags

Classroom Supplies (DO NOT LABEL!)

- 1 package of 3x3 sticky notes—not accordion style (post it preferred)
- 2 packages sharpened 24 count pencils (Dixon Ticonderoga preferred)
- 3 blue or black ballpoint pens
- 3 red ballpoint pens
- 1 pack of colored pencils **OR** washable markers
- 1 pack of cap erasers
- 2 black Sharpies **OR** 2 black felt tip pens (i.e. Bic Flair)
- 2 highlighters
- 2-3 large glue sticks

Please label the following these items with first & last name

- 1 pair of scissors
- 4 pocket folders-assorted colors (heavy duty plastic preferred)
- 5 spiral notebooks-assorted colors, wide-ruled
- 2-1 ½ inch heavy duty, hard cover binders with interior pockets and exterior plastic cover

- Headphones or earbuds

4K Supply List

School Requests for Parents to Supply:

- Tissue/Puffs- 2 Boxes
- 2 family size packages of napkins
- Dixie cups
- *Extra clothes* in a large ziploc (shirt, pants, socks, underwear-change the contents for winter)
- Ziploc bags (A-L names gallon, M-Z names quart)
- 2 Pocket folders (Plastic preferred - one for documentation and one for Friday Folder)
- Snacks (for the class to share-bulk)
- Washable Markers (pip squeaks are preferred)
- Kid scissors (Fiskars preferred)
- Glue bottle (smaller for little hands is best - Elmer's preferred)
- Large glue sticks
- Backpack- school size
- Baby wipes
- Crayola crayons (fat ones if you can find them)
- Envelopes (for writing center)
- Dry erase markers (they now make these washable!)

Other ideas:

Sensory items: Shaving cream, tartar or alum for playdough along with food coloring, tape (clear and masking), corn starch, salt (large container), Play-Doh, Clear Glitter Glue, Saline Solution, Water Beads.

Art items: pretty paper scraps from scrap booking, beads, stickers, stamp pads, bingo dotters/ Dot dobbers, pipe cleaners, buttons.

Other: shoes/Boots without laces (for winter and/or gym time if we get it), slippers for inside the classroom are optional instead of shoes but we may not be in stocking feet.

P.S.

Future reminder: a list of outdoor clothing needed is helpful (especially for families new to WI winters!). Hats, mittens (not gloves), boots, snow pants and coat are recommended.
