Kindergarten

Shared Supplies (do not label):

- 1 box of Kleenex
- 3 –any color felt-tip markers; fine tip (Papermate preferred).
- Last name: A-M one box Ziplock gallon bags; N-Z 1 pack of pink erasers (not pencil top).
- 1 pack Dry Erase Markers (Expo preferred).
- 24 glue sticks
- 12 #2 pencils (not shiny coated). Please sharpen.

Please label ONLY these items with first & last name:

- 3 – 24 count boxes of crayons (Crayola preferred)
- 1 Scissors with metal cutting edge. (Fiskars preferred)
- 1 pack colored pencils. (Crayola preferred)
- 4 – two-pocket folders with bottom pockets.
- 1 box of Washable markers – set of 8 or 10, primary colors only. (Crayola preferred)
- 2 – Spiral bound notebooks, wide lined, no larger than 70 count.
- Plastic school box (approx. 5" x 8" to hold supplies, no handles).
- Backpack or school bag to be brought to school every day.
- Adult-size pullover T-shirt for painting.
- Change of clothes for season (socks, underwear, pants, shirt). Labeled in plastic bag.

First Grade

Shared Supplies (do not label):

- 1 bottle of school glue
- 1 box gallon-size storage bags (Students with last names beginning with A-L only.)
- 1 box quart-size storage bags (Students with last names beginning with M-Z only.)
- 2 boxes 24-count crayons
- 1 box wide markers
- 1 box colored pencils (sharpened)
- 2 large boxes of facial tissues
- 1 pack pink erasers (Pink Pearl preferred)
- 1 black and white composition notebook

- 3 wide-ruled spiral notebooks - labeled with name on front, upper right-hand corner.
- 1 pencil box, approximate size 8"x5"x2"
- 1 pair of scissors (Fiskars brand preferred)
- Art smock
- Earphones
- Backpack
- Gym shoes to be worn on gym days

Second Grade

Shared Supplies (do not label):

- 2 dozen pencils – sharpened (Dixon or Ticonderoga preferred)
- 1 box of tissues
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 pack 3x3 post it notes
- 2 pink erasers (not pencil cap erasers)
- 1 package of 20 plastic page protectors for three ring binders
- 3 felt tip markers, fine tip (any color) last names A-M
- 3 highlighters (any color) last names N-Z
- 1 pkg dry erase markers, chisel tip (Expo preferred)

Please label ONLY these items with first & last name:

- 1 child sized scissors (pointed okay)
- 1 box of washable markers
- 1 box colored pencils Plastic School box, approx.. 5"x8"
- 1 box 24 crayons
- 1 three ring plastic binder (1 inch)
- 2 wide rule spiral notebooks (not composition books)
- 4 two-l pocket folders (standard size)
- Earphones
- Backpack
- Gym shoes to be worn on gym days

Third Grade

Shared Supplies (do not label):

- 1 supply box to hold small supplies
- 2 pkg 24 count #2 sharpened pencils
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 2 traditional pink erasers
- 1 pack pencil cap erasers
- 3 small glue sticks
- 1 wooden or non-bendable plastic ruler with inches and centimeters
- 1 4oz bottle of white glue
- 1 pair scissors
- 2 boxes of tissues- 100 count or more
- 1 3-inch by 3-inch pack of sticky notes
- 1 package of dry erase markers- low odor
- 1 box zip top storage bags: gallon size (Last name M-Z) or quart size (Last name A-L)
- 1 oversized t-shirt or art smock (keep at school)

- 1 pack of colored pencils or washable markers
- 1 pack of cap erasers
- 2 highlighters

- 3 pocket folders-assorted colors (heavy duty plastic preferred)
- 5 spiral notebooks-assorted colors, wide-ruled
- 2-1 ½ inch 3-ring binders with interior pockets
- Headphones or ear buds
- Backpack
- Gym shoes to be worn on PE days

4K Supply List

School Requests for Parents to Supply:

2 boxes, Tissue/Puffs

2 family size packages of napkins

Dixie cups

Extra clothes in a large Ziploc bag (shirt, pants, socks, underwear-change the contents for winter)

Ziploc bags (A-L names gallon, M-Z names quart)

2 Pocket folders (Plastic preferred - one for documentation and one for Friday Folder)

Snacks (for the class to share-bulk)

Washable Markers (pip squeaks are preferred)

Kid brand scissors (Fiskars brand preferred)

Glue bottles (smaller for little hands is best, Elmer's brand preferred)

Large glue sticks

Backpack- school size

Baby wipes

Crayons (fat ones if you can find them, Crayola brand preferred)

Envelopes (for writing center)

Dry erase markers (they now make these washable!)

Other ideas:

Sensory items: Shaving cream, tartar or alum for playdough along with food coloring, tape (clear and masking), corn starch, salt (large container), Play-DOH, Clear Glitter Glue, Saline Solution, Water Beads.

Art items: pretty paper scraps from scrap booking, beads, stickers, stamp pads, bingo dotters/ Dot dobbers, pipe cleaners, buttons.

Other: shoes/Boots without laces (for winter and/or gym time if we get it), slippers for inside the classroom are optional instead of shoes but we may not be in stocking feet.

P.S.

Future reminder: a list of outdoor clothing needed is helpful (especially for families new to WI winters!). Hats, mittens (not gloves), boots, snow pants and coat are recommended.
