Individual classroom teachers may ask for additional supplies after the school year starts

### 4K

#### Shared Supplies (do not label):

- 1 bottle of glue (Elmer's is preferred)
- 2 glue sticks (Elmer's is preferred)
- 1 small box of tissues
- 2 healthy class snacks (each enough for 18 children) – such as string cheese, fruit strips, fruit cups, applesauce, yogurt tubes, raisins, rice cakes

#### **Donations appreciated!**

Flour, salt, vinegar, baking soda, shaving cream, permanent markers, lunch bags, toothpicks, pipe cleaners, paper plates, aluminum foil, cream of tartar, glitter glue, disinfecting wipes (Clorox preferred)

#### Please label ONLY these items with first & last name:

- Spare set of clothes-- put in a plastic bag and labeled with your child's name. Include spare underwear, shirt, pants and socks.
- Backpack (no wheels) – Big enough to hold folders, books, artwork, messages, etc.
- 2 plastic pocket folders

## Kindergarten

### Shared Supplies (do not label):

- 1 pack of pink erasers (preferably Pink Pearl)
- 4 boxes of crayons (preferably Crayola)
- 2 boxes of Broad Line markers (preferably Crayola)
- Expo-Dry erase markers (5) - black
- 1 box of Fine Line markers (preferably Crayola)
- 6-12 glue sticks (preferably Elmers)
- 2 bottles white liquid glue (Elmer's 4 oz. size preferred)
- 24 regular yellow pencils (please sharpen, preferably Ticonderoga)
- 2 plain, 2-pocket folders with fasteners (red and green)
- 1 composition notebook
- 2 boxes facial tissues
- 3 boxes of healthy nut-free snack--we'll ask for more in the newsletter as it is needed
- Last name A-F: 1 box sandwich sized zipper bags
- Last name G-M: 1 box of gallon-size zipper bags (preferably with slider)
- Last name N-Z: 1 box of quart-size zipper bags (preferably with slider)
- 1 container of hand sanitizer

### Wish List for the art area::

Paper, stickers, envelopes, playdough, ribbon, scotch tape, masking tape, yarn, old greeting cards, pipe cleaners, paper towel and toilet paper tubes, paper plates

### Please label ONLY these items with first & last name:

- Art smock -old adult t-shirt works best

## First Grade

### Shared Supplies (do not label):

- 36 **sharpened** pencils (Ticonderoga preferred)
- 1 three pack large glue sticks (preferably Elmer's but no pink or purple glue)
- 2 boxes washable markers (preferably Crayola)
- 1 wide-ruled spiral notebook
- 4 solid colored plastic folders (NOT labeled with name, one each of red, blue, yellow, green)
- 2 large boxes tissues
- 3 non-perishable, healthy snacks for the entire class (we will request more snacks as needed)
- 2 large boxes tissues
- 1 canister of cleaning wipes (safe for hands)
- 1 package of 2-4 fine tipped dry erase markers (Expo preferred)
- 1 box of plastic baggies—last names A-M bring gallon size while N-Z bring sandwich size (Ziploc freezer bags preferred)

- 1 Wide-lined **Composition** notebook (black and white marble cover)
- 6 Glue Sticks
- 2 boxes of Tissues (large box, no travel size)
- 1 box Sandwich/**quart** size zipper bags
- 6 PLASTIC** (poly) Folders: 1 each blue, green, red, yellow, orange, purple
- 1 box of 24 or less Crayons
- 1 box of 8 Washable markers, large
- 1 pack Erasers
- 1 box or bag of nonperishable snack for the class on a monthly basis
