DUE TO COVID AND UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE STUDENTS MAY NOT SHARE SCHOOL SUPPLIES

All Grade Levels Need the Following:

2 Masks/Face Coverings (no bandanas)

Hand Sanitizer- 60%-95% Alcohol

2 plastic bins to keep supplies in (ex. 12" x 9"), one for school and one for home

To the best of your ability please label all supplies with student's first and last name

All snacks must be prepackaged and individually wrapped

Individual classroom teachers may ask for additional supplies after the school year starts

4K

- 1 pack of washable markers- broad line
- 1 pack of washable markers- fine line
- 1 pack of colored pencils **OR** crayons
- 1 bottle of white school glue
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 small box of tissues
- 2 Individually wrapped healthy class snacks (each enough for 18 children) – such as string cheese, fruit strips, fruit cups, applesauce, yogurt tubes, raisins,
- 1 box of quart **or** gallon size storage bags (Ziploc preferred)
- 1 container of modeling compound, any color (Play-doh preferred)
- Extra clothes—send a bag with two extra sets of clothing (warm and cold weather), including socks and underpants. Label both the bag and each item of clothing with your child's name.
- Backpack – Big enough to hold folders, books, artwork, messages.
- 2 plastic pocket folders (any design, character or colors)

Kindergarten

- 3 boxes of crayons (preferably Crayola)
- 3 boxes of Broad Line markers (preferably Crayola)
- Dry erase markers (5) - black (preferably Expo)
- 1 box of Fine Line markers (preferably Crayola)
- 1 box of 24 Colored Pencils (preferably Crayola)
- 6-12 glue sticks (preferably Elmer's)
- 24 regular yellow pencils (please sharpen, preferably Ticonderoga)
- 2 plain, 2-pocket folders with fasteners (blue and green)
- 1 spiral notebook
- 2 boxes facial tissues
- 3 boxes of individually wrapped healthy nut-free snack--we'll ask for more in the newsletter as it is needed
- Last name A-L: 1 box of gallon-size zipper bags (preferably with slider)
- Last name M-Z: 1 box of quart-size zipper bags (preferably with slider)
- Art smock -old adult t-shirt works best
- Backpack: large-sized to accommodate a big folder easily, but with no wheels as these do not fit in lockers well
- Spare set of clothes— Put in a plastic bag and labeled with your child's name. Include spare underwear, pants, and socks, although a full set of clothes is even better. (Spills and other accidents can happen to anyone!) You may wish to change the clothes in this bag seasonally, so they are temperature-appropriate.
- Gym shoes (optional)- in case you are prone to forget sneakers on gym days
- 1 2-pocket folder (any design)
- pencil box/supply box
- child size scissors

First Grade

- 36 **sharpened** pencils (Ticonderoga preferred)
- 1 three pack large glue sticks (preferably Elmer's but no pink or purple glue)
- 2 boxes washable markers (preferably Crayola)
- 2 wide-ruled spiral notebooks (one blue and one red)
- 1 Wide-lined **Composition** notebook
- 2 solid colored plastic folders with prongs (one red and one blue)
- 2 folders of your choice
- 2 boxes of 24 count crayons
- 1 box of 12 colored pencils (preferably Crayola)
- 1 plastic supply box for pencils and crayons
- 1 child size scissors (pointed and Fiskars brand preferred)
- 1 bottle white school glue
- 2 large boxes tissues
- 3 non-perishable, individually wrapped healthy snacks for the entire class (peanut/tree nut free, we will request more snacks as needed)
- 1 package of 2-4 fine tipped, dry erase, black markers (Expo preferred)
- 1 box of plastic baggies—last names A-M bring gallon size while N-Z bring sandwich size (Ziploc freezer bags preferred)
- Art smock-an old adult t-shirt works best
- Notebooks and folders
