Please note the following:

- The test will be updated to reflect the outcome of State and Federal elections. The updated versions will be available, in various languages, typically within a month of the official changes in office holders.
- If a district other than MMSD uses this test as a guide, please understand that Question #23 will need to be changed to represent who is the US representative for your district.
- The Supreme Court questions represent current membership.
- All language versions have the same answer sequence. You will also need to change question #23.
- There is an audio version on the MMSD web site. This could be used for ELL students who may need a little extra support. Again, question #23 represents Madison's representative.
