Test results will be used by the district to inform future decisions related to curriculum and instruction, however the context and time when the test was given will always be taken into consideration. Decisions regarding individual student performance will always use multiple sources of information over time.

The results are intended to show if a student is "on track" to be college and career ready by the time they graduate from high school. This information should be used in conversations with schools regarding course selection and future planning.
